2012 will be the fifth year that ACCET has offered grants to the church of Christ in Australia and we praise God that this resource exists to help support the work of evangelism in this country.



TIMELINE FOR 2012 GRANTS

- 1 September, 2011** 2012 grant applications invited.
- 16 November, 2011** Your grant application must be submitted by 4pm on the 16/11/2011. Late applications can not be accepted.
- 15 December, 2011** Notifications will be sent to grant applicants informing them of whether or not their application has been approved.
- 1 January, 2012** First quarter grant payment made.
- 1 April, 2012** Second quarter grant payment made.
- 1 July, 2012** Third quarter grant payment made.
- 1 October, 2012** Fourth quarter grant payment made.

GRANT GUIDELINES

- ✓ The application must be received by cut off date - 16/11/2011.
- ✓ The application must be lodged by a congregation of the non-denominational church of Christ or by a ministry run by Christians of the non-denominational church of Christ within Australia.
- ✓ The applicant must adhere to the application procedures outlined in this brochure (page 5).
- ✓ The application must be consistent with the purposes articulated in the Trust Deed.
- ✓ Applications cannot be lodged by an individual.
- ✓ Grants will be approved for a maximum two year term. Re-application should be lodged after the second year for another grant, if required.
- ✓ Grants will not be given for purposes that are predominantly dependent on ACCET for funding.
- ✓ Grants will not be given for capital expenditure (e.g. cars, buildings, fittings and furnishings).
- ✓ Payments for grants will only be made quarterly.
- ✓ Applicant must be willing to provide a regular update to ACCET on the progress of the work (worker) benefitting from the grant.
- ✓ All grants are provided as a non-repayable free gift.



APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The Trustees prefer applications to be lodged in your own writing and format. There is no 'application form' as such, we just ask you to cover the points below succinctly. Grant proposals should be made in writing by the elders, or the leading members of the congregation in the absence of elders, and include the following information:



1. A summary of your request. An outline of the particular worker / work you are requiring funding for.
2. The specific dollar amount requested from ACCET for the proposed work, along with a proposed schedule of reductions if ongoing assistance is requested beyond one year.
3. A brief history of the congregation (Bible college, ministry) making the request.
4. How does the application fit in with the Trust's objectives of using the fund to help support evangelists, full-time workers, the training of preachers, domestic missions, schools and colleges of Biblical Studies, the creation of evangelistic publications and literature, amongst other things?
5. What measurable goals and objectives does the congregation have in relation to the application?
6. A description of the proposed work for which support is being requested and the specific dollar amount provided by the requesting church, for the proposed work.
7. Add anything else you believe would help ACCET understand your situation. Don't forget the contact details of someone we can talk to about the application.

PRIORITISING GRANTS

Although the Trustees would like to support every grant request, it is anticipated that the demand for support will be greater than the investment returns ACCET allocates annually for grants. In this regard, the Trustees have determined a prioritisation matrix that assists in the ranking of applications. The ranking is as follows:

- Priority 1)** An existing worker requiring extra support.
- Priority 2)** Assist with the employment of a new worker.
- Priority 3)** Support of a student in full-time Bible study or preacher training.
- Priority 4)** Funding a short term evangelistic mission.
- Priority 5)** Design and publication of evangelistic material and Bible study aids.
- Priority 6)** Advertising and marketing.

NOT ALL PROJECTS CAN BE FUNDED

The Trustees of the Australian church of Christ Evangelistic Trust have responsibility for the final approval of each grant. Since ACCET will likely receive funding requests in excess of its ability to fund, only a portion of requests can be approved. A decision not to fund a proposal does not necessarily reflect on the merits of the applicant or the value of the proposal.
